



1 Mt. Jinba

A hiking spot where you can look out over Mt. Fuji, Enoshima and the Boso peninsula.

2 Obara-juku Honjin Koshu-Kaido Road Obarajuku Honjin Festival

Obara-juku Honjin is the only existing Honjin literally, 'headquarters' in Kanagawa Prefecture, and was the official lodging designated to be used by Daemyo (feudal lords) on their way to Edo for their alternate attendance duty. The procession of Daemyo is reenacted during the festival.

3 Lake Tsukui

The Kanagawa Prefectural Lake Tsukui Shiroyama Park is a well known place to view cherry blossoms. Beautiful throughout the four seasons, you can enjoy the spectacular autumn foliage in the autumn and even try ice-fishing in the winter.

9 Hashimoto Tanabata Festival

The highlight of this festival is the 200 decorative bamboo plants. This festival is one of Kanagawa Prefecture's 50 best festivals!

11 Oyama Park New Sports Plaza

This area is for skateboarding, BMX riding, 3 on 3 basketball and street dancing. It's equipped with lighting so you can enjoy these sports into the night.

13 Kamimizo Summer Festival

A festival boasting a history and tradition that dates back to the Edo period. Over 20 "mikoshi" portable shrines and floats make this a memorable festival to attend. Kamimizo Summer Festival is one of the best 50 festivals in Kanagawa Prefecture!

17 Sagami City Museum

Precious JAXA documents and materials that cannot be found anywhere else are displayed here in the astronomy exhibition room, whose theme is "Connect to Space".

3 Lake Sagami

Lake Sagami is a lake in which one can enjoy rowing, pleasure cruises, cherry blossoms, fireworks and even ice-fishing! It's a place to be enjoyed throughout the seasons. The Lake Sagami Fireworks Festival is one of the top 50 festivals in Kanagawa!

10 Sagami-hara-Kita Park

Enjoy nature's beauty throughout the seasons. With tens of thousands of plants, there are 200 varieties of flora such as plum trees, roses, etc.

12 Sagami-hara Citizens' Cherry Blossom Festival

Musical performances, stage performance and a parade are all part of this grand festival, held among the beauty of over 200 cherry blossom trees.

13 JAXA Sagami-hara Campus

JAXA Sagami-hara Campus is the base for space science research that created many rockets and satellites, including "Hayabusa 2", an asteroid probe now on its voyage to an asteroid named "Ryugu" with a mission to collect samples and return home.

4 Love Letter from Nature

This is a huge outdoor artwork that is visible from the Chuo Expressway and the JR Chuo main line.

5 Fujino Yamanami Hot Spring

Located up on a small mountain, the view from the outdoor bath of this hot spring is quite lovely.

19 Ginga Arena

Composite facilities consist of an international standard ice rink (writer only) and training room. The facility has produced some Olympic athletes in short track speed skating.
